**INPATIENT ONCOLOGY PAVILION RENOVATION** The Pavilion will be completely transformed to create a healing environment and will be home to 20 inpatient rooms, 2 family overnight suites, a nursing station, conference area, staff respite suite, comfort and healing lounge, kitchen and integrative medicine suite.



**RESEARCH** Clinical trials help find cures for cancer. Through our partnership with Smilow Cancer Hospital at Yale-New Haven, our patients will have the ability to participate in the most innovative clinical trials available.



**PROGRAMS AND SERVICES** An essential part of our Mission is making world-class, compassionate care accessible for everyone, regardless of their ability to pay. Our patient and community funds help individuals learn about early cancer detection, prevention methods and how to survive a cancer diagnosis.



**EXPANSION AND RENOVATION** The expansion of our Cancer Center will increase the current footprint to provide additional space to improve the delivery of service to our patients. This includes 32 comfortable infusion suites to address the growing need for cancer treatment in our region.



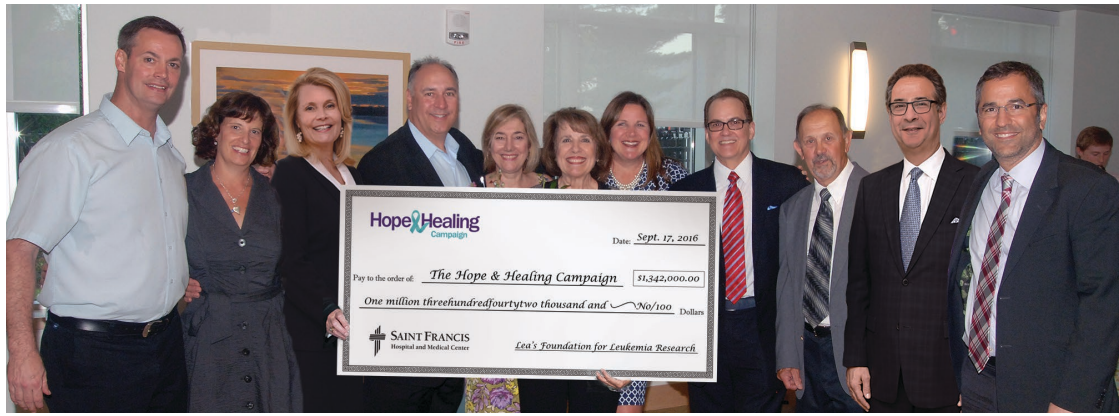

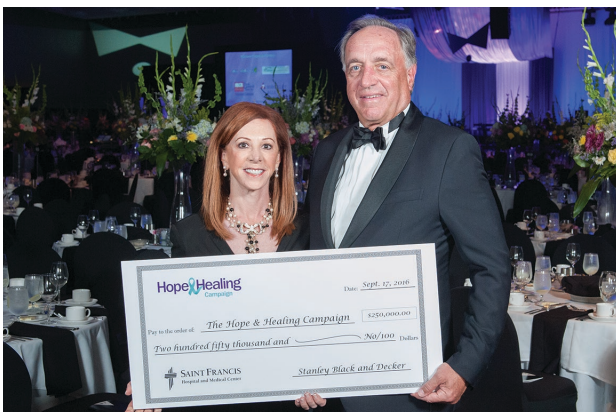
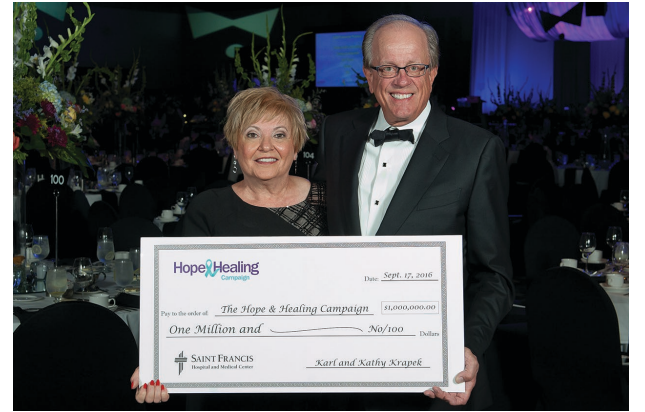
